




School walk-through on 6/19/2020

UFT Teacher Surveys

Some Highlights

- **92%:** Prefer to continue remote learning
- **45%:** Very Uncomfortable or Extremely Uncomfortable returning to the building
- **62%:** Have little to no confidence that adequate health and safety measures will be taken
- 9%: Not concerned about themselves, but are concerned about the impact of people in their life as a result of their return
- 73%: Little to no confidence the building can be adequately sanitized

Parent Surveys

Some Highlights

- 53% Very or Mostly Comfortable sending child to school every day
- 81% Important that staff and student are required to wear a mask
- 29% Child is Very Comfortable wearing a mask to school
- 53% Listed sending child to school on certain days and remote learning the rest of the time as 1st choice
- 74% Students use public transportation to get to school

A brief discussion of some key terms

Synchronous learning refers to a learning event in which the instructor and a group of participants are engaged in the learning process at the same time.

EXAMPLES

- 1. Traditional classroom
- 2. Instant messaging
- 3. Immediate feedback (instructor & peers)
- 4. Phone call
- 5. In-person training
- 6. Live webinar
- 7. Group-paced
- 8. Same time

Asynchronous learning refers to a learning event where the instructor, the learner, and other participants are not engaged in the learning process at the same time.

EXAMPLES

- 1. Recorded class
- 2. Email
- 3. Send a question, wait for an answer
- 4. Recorded voice message
- 5. Online training course (without live video)
- 6. Recorded webinar
- 7. Self-paced
- 8. Different times

"Remote" Instruction

Bulldog Fridays to offer club activities (both in-person and remote), in-person tutoring, and extended office hours to connect with teachers synchronously.

For one day each week, students come into the building for in-person synchronous instruction.

Teachers of the class will provide mostly asynchronous activities for the other days.

Four days a week, students meet with their teachers for synchronous instruction utilizing remote platforms.

Some essential reminders regarding In-Building safety protocols

Everyone must wear a face mask when in the building (students, faculty, and staff)

Although individuals are encouraged to bring their own, we will have a supply on hand to provide to those in need

Students who refuse to wear a mask put others at risk and will be switched to a "Remote" schedule

- Before entering the building students, faculty, and staff must show that they filled out a daily health check survey
- Random temperature checks will occur for students entering the campus
- All faculty, staff, and visitors will be screened for temperature upon entry
- Students who come to school on the wrong day will be sent home
- ALL MUST observe social distancing and should avoid unnecessary contact with surfaces
