PA Roles & Responsibilities

■ What is a PA?

Parent Associations (PAs) are school-based organizations open to all parents/guardians of children currently attending a New York City public school.

■ What is the role of the PA?

The PA is a great way for parents/ guardians to become involved in their children's education, share ideas, and enrich their school communities. Each PA develops its own bylaws, elects officers, and holds regular meetings.

- What are the mandatory PA positions?
- President- Should preside at all meetings of the association and delegate responsibilities to other association members. Encourage participation in parent and school activities. A core member of the School Leadership Team (SLT). Attend the president council meetings monthly.
- Treasurer- Responsible for all financial affairs and funds of the association. Complete the midterm and annual financial report and present these forms at the general meetings.
- **Recording Secretary-** Records minutes at all association meetings and assists in the preparation of notices, agendas, sign in sheets, and materials for distribution.

What is a SLT?

- The School Leadership Team (SLT) is a group of people who develop educational policies for their school. They also make sure there are resources to support those policies.
- Provide ongoing evaluations of a school's educational programs and their impact on student achievement.
- Play an important role in school-based decision-making.
- Help to make school cultures more collaborative.
