**Students and their families can be awarded a one-time, unconditional grant of \$1,000 through NYC Health + Hospitals/Gotham Health for living expenses to address financial challenges related to a COVID-19 diagnosis.**

**Students or family members under the age of 21 can be seen by LIC HS Health Center Nurse Practitioners to screen for eligibility. Students or family members need to have a COVID-19 diagnosis.**

*Eligibility Criteria:*

- *Enrolled in care with NYC Health+Hospitals at an inpatient, outpatient, emergency department, or home care setting in 2020/21*
- *Past or present COVID-19 diagnosis from student or family member*
- *Low-income, or reports substantial economic hardship (job loss, inability to meet basic needs)*
- *NYC resident (regardless of immigration status)*
- *Consent from parent/legal guardian for patients under the age of 18*
- *Referred by NYC Health + Hospitals care team member*

**The LIC HS Health Center is still open as the school remains remote**
