With an NYC Schools Account, you can view your child's Report Cards, Attendance, Test Scores, Transportation Schedules, Graduation Tracker and much more!


Also, an NYC Schools Account is the only way to apply and vote in the 2021 Education Council Elections.




1. Visit https://mystudent.nyc/

Use the dropdown box to choose your home language to be displayed on the screen.






2. Click "Create Account".




3. Enter your name, cell phone number, and email, then click the "Validate Email" button.




4. Check your email for a message from NYCSA@schools.nyc.gov for the 6 digit code.

5. Enter the code into the "Email Verification Number" box. Then click "Submit".




6. Create a password following the guidelines.



7. Select 3 security questions and provide answers. Be sure to write your **Password and Anwsers to the Security Questions** down and secure them in a familiar place.




8. If you do not have your OSIS # and Account Creation Code, you may click on "Continue Without Code." Your Parent Coordinator will follow up with you to provide the information.




9. Enter each child's student ID # (OSIS). You can also find the number on any report card or by contacting your Parent Coordinator.
