RE:

GAME PROCEDURES AT LONG ISLAND CITY HIGH SCHOOL

- 1. Game time is 4:30 P.M. unless otherwise noted.
- 2. The coach must accompany the team into the building, and escort the team from the building at the conclusion of the game.
- 3. Players are not to arrive before 3:50 P.M. All players, accompanied by the coach, are to use the main entrance on Broadway. Only players on the official PSAL roster including managers will be allowed access.
- 4. Locker room space is still currently unavailable, please have your teams dressed to play.
- 5. No visiting cheerleaders/ boosters/spectators of any kind will permitted at any LICHS athletic events.
- 6. LICHS reserves the right to allow only LICHS students with ID cards, teachers, and parents of LICHS varsity team players with proof of vaccination/DOE Health survey entry to athletic events.
- 7. No one will be allowed to come back into the school once they leave the building.
- 8. No food or beverages are allowed in the gym.
- 9. Half-times must be actively supervised by security.
- 10. All security will remain in the gym/field until everyone has left the facility.
- 11. Any student who misbehaves will be ejected and will not be able to return to any varsity game in the future.
- 12. The locker room doors must be kept locked at all times during the game. Security must patrol the locker room occasionally to check for intruders.
- 13. All personal belongings must remain with the team at all times. (No items are to be left in the locker room).

14. Students serving any type of school suspension are not permitted to attend LICHS athletic events.
